


## **Enhancements to TESSA (February 2025)**

## WH1 implementations with an Implementation Date after the 19th of December 2024 are not eligible for PRC creation in TESSA

TESSA system has been updated to reflect that WH1 implementations with an implementation date after 19 December 2024 are not eligible for certificate creation, per the recent PDRS Rule change.

This means that TESSA will automatically reject the upload of any CSV Implementation Data file where the PDRS Activity Definition is WH1 and the implementation date is later than 19 December 2024.

This reflects the EDM issued in December 2024 announcing that heat pump water activity WH1 is not eligible for certificate creation after 19 December 2024.



## Status now visible on the published list of ACPs and Accreditations

The Published List of ACPs and Accreditations in TESSA now displays a "Status" column showing whether each accreditation listed is Active, Suspended or Cancelled.

Under our legislative requirements, IPART must keep a register of Accredited Certificate Providers (ACPs) that includes details about ACP suspensions and cancellations.

Information about ACP suspensions and cancellations is kept in IPART's TESSA system but has not been viewable in the external ACPs and Accreditations view to date.
